

Armenian Folia Anglistika – the official peer-reviewed academic journal of the Armenian Association for the Study of English (since 2005) and Yerevan State University (since 2015) aims at fostering research of the English Language and Linguistics, Literature, Methodology, Culture, Translation Studies, and Gender Studies, fostering academic dialogue within Armenia and across the global scholarly community. It facilitates intellectual cooperation between high school teachers and scholars.

In 2007, the Editorial Board of *Armenian Folia Anglistika* inaugurated a new section entitled Armenological Studies, designed to encourage valuable and innovative research in the areas of Armenian Linguistics, Literature, Ethnic Studies, History, Cultural History, and Genocide Studies. This section emphasizes the role of English in framing and mediating discourse on these subjects and aims to promote interdisciplinary dialogue, contributing to a deeper understanding of Armenia's cultural and intellectual heritage within a global academic context.

Armenian Folia Anglistika is intended to be published twice a year. Articles of interest to university-level teachers and scholars in English Studies are warmly welcomed by the multi-national Editorial Board of the Journal.
